Certification

I understand that criminal background checks and checks of public sex offender and child abuse websites/registries are required every five years and upon learning of information that reasonably may suggest unsuitability, and individuals will not be found suitable to interact with participating minors in the course of activities under the VOCA award if an individual:

- a.) withholds consent to a criminal history search required by this certified assurance;
- b.) knowingly makes (or made) a false statement that affects, or is intended to affect, any search required by this condition;
- c.) is listed as a registered sex offender on the Dru Sjodin National Sex Offender Public Website; or
- d.) to my knowledge, has been convicted whether as a felony or misdemeanor under federal, state, tribal, or local law for any of the following crimes or any substantially equivalent criminal offence, regardless of specific words by which it may be identified in law:
 - 1.) sexual or physical abuse, neglect, or endangerment of an individual under 18 at the time of offense;
 - 2.) rape/sexual assault, including conspiracy to commit rape/sexual assault;
 - 3.) sexual exploitation, such as through child pornography or sex trafficking;
 - 4.) kidnapping;
 - 5.) voyeurism; or
 - 6.) is determined by a federal, state, tribal, or local government agency not to be suitable
