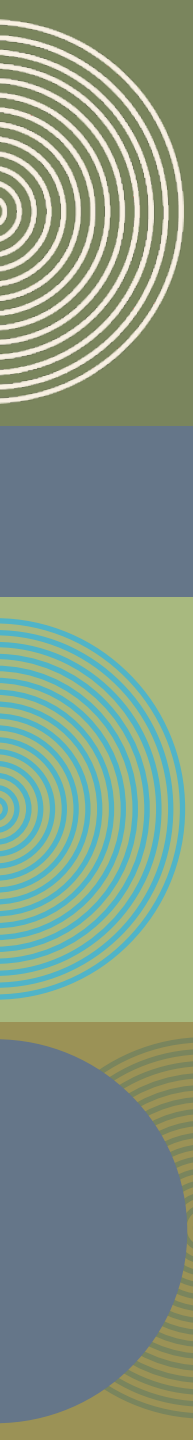

NEW STATE CAC FUNDING



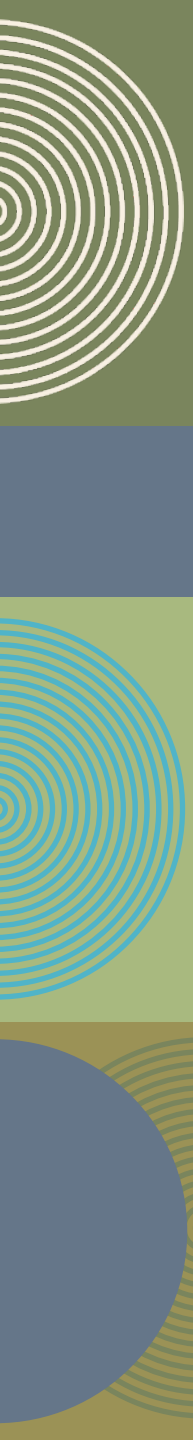
STATE FY26 FUNDING

Senate Bill No. 1203 (one time appropriation)

- State FY26 CAC Available Funding: **\$3,000,000**
- State FY27 CAC Anticipated Funding: **Unknown, if any**

State Fiscal Year = July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026




STATE CAC ELIGIBILITY

CAC or organization containing a CAC

- CAC means an organization that adheres to national best practice standards established by the national membership and accrediting body for children's advocacy centers and that promotes a comprehensive and coordinated multidisciplinary team response to allegations of child abuse by maintaining a child-friendly facility at which appropriate services are provided. These services may include forensic interviews, forensic medical examinations, mental health services, and other related victim services.
- Programs actively working toward accreditation are also eligible for State CAC funding.

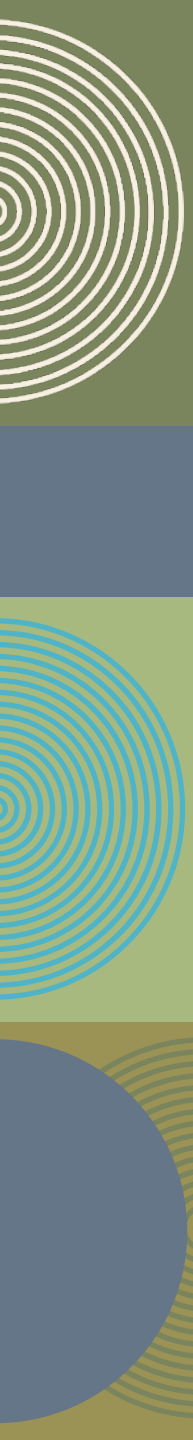


MATCH REQUIREMENTS

CHANGES TO FY25 AWARD

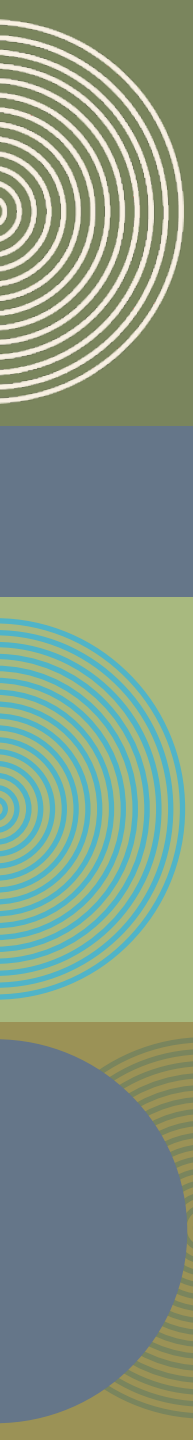




Q4 OF FY25 AWARD

- Reallocation of some FY25 funds to be replaced by State CAC funds
 - These State CAC funds can be utilized for expenses from July 1, 2025 – September 30, 2025
- Jotform will need to be completed for us to determine reallocation
- Amendment to FY25 award will need to be completed for reallocation (your Grant Manager will be working on this)
- Reporting for Q4 will also include a State CAC report in AmpliFund (same report as national report)
