Health and Human Services, Family Violence Prevention & Services Act (FVPSA)



State of Idaho, Domestic Violence Project (State DV)

VOCA

Three-year award

Budget for one year

Estimated Awards: 50

Funding availability:

- FY2021: \$13,775,400
- FY2022: \$11,804,131
- FY2023: TBD

VOCA Eligibility

i. Victim service organization whose principle mission is to provide services to crime victims; or

ii. A public or non-profit organization that has a component whose principle mission is to provide services to crime victims. These organizations are eligible if the funds are used to expand or enhance the delivery of crime victim services.

A “component” is defined as follows: a specific program within the organizational framework of an agency, whose principal purpose is to provide direct services to victims of crime. The program is under the administrative structure of an established organization and the program’s goals and objectives reflect how it expands or enhances services to victims of crime.

FVPSA

One-year award

Estimated awards: 30

FY2021: \$930,000

FVPSA Eligibility

i. A local public agency or nonprofit private organization that assists victims of family violence, domestic violence, or dating violence and their dependents; or

ii. A partnership with two or more agencies that includes:
A) an agency described above; and
B) an agency that has a demonstrated history of serving populations in their communities.

Use of funds:

- A) Shelter & shelter related services – 70% (minimum)
 - B) Public awareness, prevention, & outreach – 25%
 - C) Administration - 5%

State DV
Fund

One-year award

Estimated awards: 16

FY2021: \$171,800

State DV Fund Eligibility

i. A private, nonprofit corporation of the State of Idaho; or

ii. A public entity of the State of Idaho

Projects must provide a safe house or refuge and a crisis line.
No funds may be granted to batterer programs.

Grant Application

Budget Worksheet

Budget Categories

Administrative Services

- All administrative costs
- Request funding levels for positions that are directly attributable to ICDVVA grants

Indirect Services

- Activities necessary to ensure provision of quality direct services
- Examples: supplies, skills training, conferences

Direct Victim Services

- Staff salaries and benefits for employees involved in direct victim services

Match Requirements



VOCA/FVPSA = 20%

State DV Funds = 25%



Cash: non-Federal money contributions

In-kind Contributions: value of non-cash contributions



Calculating project match:

Award/.80 less award = Match amount

$\$50,000 / .80 = \$62,500 - \$50,000 = \$12,500$

*Application budget automatically calculates required match

- ALL supporting documents MUST be included in the application packet
