Welcome & Introductions	Doug called the meeting to order. Introductions were conducted:  Doug Graves has been elected Chair and Len Humphries has been elected Vice Chair. The Governor has appointed Wes Somerton as the Region 1 Representative and Monica Morrison as the Region 3 Representative.  Lisa Just was introduced as the Grants/Contracts Program Specialist.	
Meeting Minutes	Doug requested approval/disapproval action on the September 8, 2017 meeting minutes.	Len made a Motion to approve the September 8, 2017 meeting minutes as presented. Sarah seconded the Motion, and the Motion was carried unanimously.
Office Update	The Office for Victims of Crime (OVC) conducted an on-site monitoring visit at the Council office November 13-17, 2017. Luann reported that there were 4 findings, which require corrective action by the Council within 30 days. Two of the findings require additions to the Council Monitoring Policies and Procedures. The other two findings will require additional documentation of information to be collected from the funded programs. There is a great importance from DOJ placed on documentation by funded programs of cash and inkind match. The ICDVVA staff will be working with	

	all funded programs to ensure that proper documentation is completed and retained.  Luann provided a budget report. The awarding amount allocated for the 2018-2019 contract year, will remain the same as the 2017-2018 contract year.  The office is coordinating the regional trainings for the VOCA Training Grant funds. There are currently three trainings being planned to be implemented in Bonner County, Boise and Idaho Falls.	
Two Days in June Conference	The 25 <sup>th</sup> Annual Two Days in June Conference will be June 7-8, 2018 at the Boise Riverside. The Save the Date card will be sent out in January. Research for presenters is currently being conducted.	-
Program Updates	Luann and Kimberly met with the Executive Director from the Elmore Domestic Violence Council regarding the difficulties they are having in staffing the advocate position that was funded through the ICDVVA grant.	An on-site visit will be conducted in January.
Monitoring Update	Kimberly and Angela conducted site visits to Voices Against Violence in Twin Falls and Family Crisis Center in Rexburg.	There were no findings that required Council action.
2018-2019 Grant Application Discussion	The grant application (RFP) will be available on the ICDVVA website on December 5, 2017. Letter of Intents will be due on January 19, 2018 with the application due date of March 16, 2018.
